I have recently developed a bad habit that I may need an intervention for. While watching TV in the evenings, I have started mulit-tasking by playing Mahjong Tiles on my IPad. This wouldn't be a problem except for the fact that my cat Smokey feels like she

needs some quality time as well. I have noticed that although I move the IPad to the side and allow Smokey to sit on my lap, she is not satisfied because I continue to try and play Mahjong. Because she does not have my undivided attention, she will usually go find another warm place to lay.

This got me to thinking about how my lack of giving my complete focus to Smokey is sometimes like my spiritual life. If you are anything like me, you can become distracted by so many things going on in your life that you fail to give God the full, undivided attention that God deserves. Although I know that I should make time to nurture my faith by intensive Bible study, prayer, or service, I regularly fail to do so. Very often I have the time for these spiritual disciplines but I don't make it a priority.

I think that's why I'm so in need of the season of Lent. This time allows me to admit that I am imperfect and broken and ask for God's help to make better choices.
